Ballot request envelopes

Envelope type	Call to action (blue/purple bold text)	Supporting text or background information
Return envelope	I want to vote by mail in the June 2 primary election! Alt Send me my ballot for the June 2 primary election!	Want to give voters a checklist, so: □ My mailing address is correct □ I signed my request form □ I'm sending this so it arrives by <date> Might also need □ I selected the party primary I want to vote in</date>
Outgoing envelope	Vote by mail in the June 2 primary election!	Provide context and reassurance for new procedures. Voting by mail is safe and the process is easy. Requesting a ballot is your first step. Complete and return the form included here to get started.

Signature or missing information envelopes

Envelope type	Call to action (blue/purple bold text)	Supporting text or background information
Signature missing	Your signature is missing!	We received your vote-by-mail ballot without a signature.

Signature doesn't match	We can't verify your signature on your vote-by-mail envelope!	We received your vote-by-mail ballot but the signature doesn't match the one on your voter registration record.
