Thank you for being a voter.



If you have questions, please contact us so we can help make your voting experience a positive one.




Mark ballot




Drop ballot

How to vote by mail

Mark your ballot

- Connect the arrow to mark your choice.
- If you make a mistake, you can get another ballot.
- Exchange it for a new ballot at the Shasta County Elections Office.
- To vote for a qualified write-in candidate see our website, elections.co.shasta.ca.us.



Sign and seal your envelope


- Follow the instructions on the envelope.
- Don't forget to **date, sign and print your name**.

Return your ballot

- **Mail** your ballot so that it is postmarked by **Election Day, November 8, 2016**.
- **Put first class postage** on the envelope.

Or, to save postage, you can:

- **Deliver** your ballot to the Shasta County Elections Office during business hours or until 8pm on Election Day (see page 2).
- **Drop off** your ballot at any Official Ballot Drop Box, any time until 8pm on Election Day (see page 2).
- **On Election Day**, take your ballot to any Shasta County polling site (see page 3).




Return your ballot at an Official Ballot Drop Box

You can return your ballot at any Shasta County Official Ballot Drop Box. They are open 24 hours a day until 8pm Election Day. No postage is required.




Look at front of the building, next to the Utility Payment Drop Box.


Look at front of the building, near the corner of Howard and Silver streets.




John Beaudet Community Center
